While the students free to reflect on any aspect of the curriculum design, relevance of a syllabus, methods of transaction of the syllabi and even the process for evaluating the attainment of educational objectives generally, we expect them to use any one of the syllabi to illustrate their points.

Following are the terms and conditions of the contest:

1. The students desirous of participation should mail their papers (word limit: approximately 1500 words) with certification from the head of their institute by **September 30, 2016** to [ugcurriculum@gmail.com](mailto:ugcurriculum@gmail.com).
2. The student should clearly indicate on the title page of their paper (1) their name, (2) class, (3) college, (4) contact number and (5) e-mail ID
3. Acceptance letter will be sent by mail by **October 03, 2016**.
4. Only if the papers are accepted will the paper-readers be invited to present their papers in the contest.
5. The selected papers will be given 15 minutes for PPT presentation.
6. Medium of presentation: English
7. All Selected papers will be published in an edited book with ISBN.
8. We will be happy to provide local hospitality to the participants and reimburse their bus tickets.
9. While all the participants will receive a participation certificate, the best three papers in the Science stream and the Arts stream will be awarded separate cash prizes:  
First Prize: Rs. 3000/-  
Second Prize: Rs. 2000/-  
Third Prize: Rs. 1000/-
10. No registration fee will be charged. However, the participants must produce a copy of their Identity Card bearing their student status in the current year.
